

Abstract of International Organizations syllabus

This course aims to analyze the most important issues regarding the International Organizations and their role in the political and juridical developments of international community. During this course will be discussed general aspects of International Organizations, history of IO, legal personality of International Organizations (IO), structure and functions of IO, membership, the IO's external relations, etc.

This course methodologically aims to help the students to be able to analyze by a critical point of view the aforementioned issues and to improve their skills in international case law and their ability to work in group.

The lessons will be based in the interactive communication between the lecturer and the students and this form will be applied especially in analyzing different aspects of IO. Part of the requirements of this course will be also the preparation and the presentation of essays.

The topics covered in this course are : History of IO and their legal personality, World politics and IO, The role of IO as a subject of International Law, The role of IO in peace and human rights promotion and protection all over the world, League of Nations, ILO, Red Cross, United Nation Organization, The purpose of its creation and its role in peace promoting and protection, Membership and decision making of UN, The structure and function of UN, Council of Europe, the history and its role, OSBC, NATO, European Union and its legal personality, Membership and decision making process in EU, International Court of Justice and its statutory, Composition and functions of ICJ, International Penal Courts. This topics are expended in 15 weeks, 3 classes of lessons and one class of seminar/ week.
